INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS AND VENDORS PLEASE READ!

If you would like more information about any of the lots, please do not hesitate to contact me. Almost every lot is accessible on the internet but prints can be supplied at 10p per sheet (plus postage). Scans for free (within reason!).

Prices in the final column of the listing are reserve-prices in British Pounds. The reserve-prices are a safety-net for vendors, and are usually set low (although some vendors can be staunch optimists!). Lots will be purchased for you at the lowest-possible price, i.e. at the reserve or at one bidding-step above an under-bidder. If equal bids are received for a lot, the first I receive will take precedence. **There is no buyer's premium.**

You may bid by post, text or **preferably by email** (but **not** by telephone). Email or text bids will be acknowledged. If you do not hear from me within three days, please contact me again. The bidding-steps are at the top of the bidding-form. Bids not conforming to bidding-steps will be **rounded up** to the next step. **Payment by buyers will preferably be by Sterling bank transfer¹ (Sort 20-98-57, Account 33393712, 'APS')** or Sterling cheque. Post € or \$ Bank notes AT YOUR RISK ONLY.

Overseas buyers may pay by VISA card or Pay-Pal, Of course, PayPal still happily charge us their fees, taking around half the Society's commission! **WE URGE VISA / PAYPAL PAYERS TO VOLUNTARILY ADD 4% TO THEIR PAYMENT** to minimise losses to the Society! Details of charges can also be seen in our journal **AUSTRIA** and will be sent with your invoice. Where feasible **I will make payments to vendors also by Bank Transfer** and will deem that payers by cheque agree to me noting the details printed on their cheque, stored in an encrypted file. If that doesn't suit you, please let me know! If you have material to sell, please note that we charge only 10% commission plus a lotting fee of 10 pence per lot (plus the return postage of unsold lots where applicable). Lotting fee – first time offered only.

Note that bidding implies acceptance of these terms. Significantly incorrectly described lots may be returned at the discretion of the Auctioneer but **this isn't an approval service!** I try to mention major defects, but you must not expect 100 year old material to be in perfect condition (especially WWI Postcards!).
