From:- PHILATELIE NEUES VON DER POST PHILATELY NEWS FROM THE POST " It is an essay for a planned Viennese communal post. In 1874, the Municipality of Vienna considered franking its letters with its own stamps and taking care of the delivery itself. The estimate was 3 kreuzers for a single letter and 6 kreuzers for a double letter. Apparently, the idea of a local post didn't meet with approval, and the project disappeared into the depths of bureaucracy. The essays for "Wiener Communalpost" remain much sought after by collectors today. In addition to the stamps, envelopes in two formats are also known. They are made of thin, strong, gray paper, measuring 155 x 122 mm, and bear the proposed 3 Kreuzer stamps in dark carmine (as illustrated), green, or black. Envelopes in a larger format of 358 x 122 mm with two overprints of 3 Kreuzer each in dark carmine and violet were planned for double letters.
